## Quest: Formation class designed for tweens




#### Renovation team recommendations:

- More youth interaction with Children
- MInistry apprenticeship opportunities for tweens
- Engaging discussion in Sunday School
- Teach Quest leaders not to judge or be authoritarian
- Institute journaling practice
- Explore youth to children mentoring opportunities

#### Ouest:

- In its second year
- 4th and 5th graders
- Next year 5th and 6th gr. then staying
- 4 leaders all year
- One year Bible
- One year BCP/Sacraments May 21
  9am Nave service
- Lots of opportunity for questions and discussion
- Service projects about once a month
- Planning ministry mentorship program

#### Renovation Team recommendations:

- Celebrate and recognize Sunday School teachers
- Anchor each classroom with at least one consistent lead teacher for the year
- Expand training so teachers better understand developmental stage of children and engagement and management strategies
- Ensure that activities are more varied and active, within a consistent structure
- Greatly increase service experiences and interactions with larger congregation
- Be open to different curricula for different age groups.
  Lectionary-based curricula are a nice-to-have.

#### Columba Crew

- Enhanced training for leaders
  - Management strategies
  - Diverse learning styles
- Focus is on connection and developing a rhythm in class
- Love First curriculum
  - Simple
  - Read same Bible story multiple weeks
  - Focus on rhythm of class
  - Lots of time for sharing, praying and reflecting on the story.

  Storytime in Nave services, special services for children St. Nick,
  Children's Christmas Pageants, Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday
- Special Events 4th graders receiving Bibles; Halloween Monster Mash Party; Advent Workshop; Preparation Sunday, Legos for Lent
- Sunday School planning lessons, preparing materials, recruiting and training leaders.
